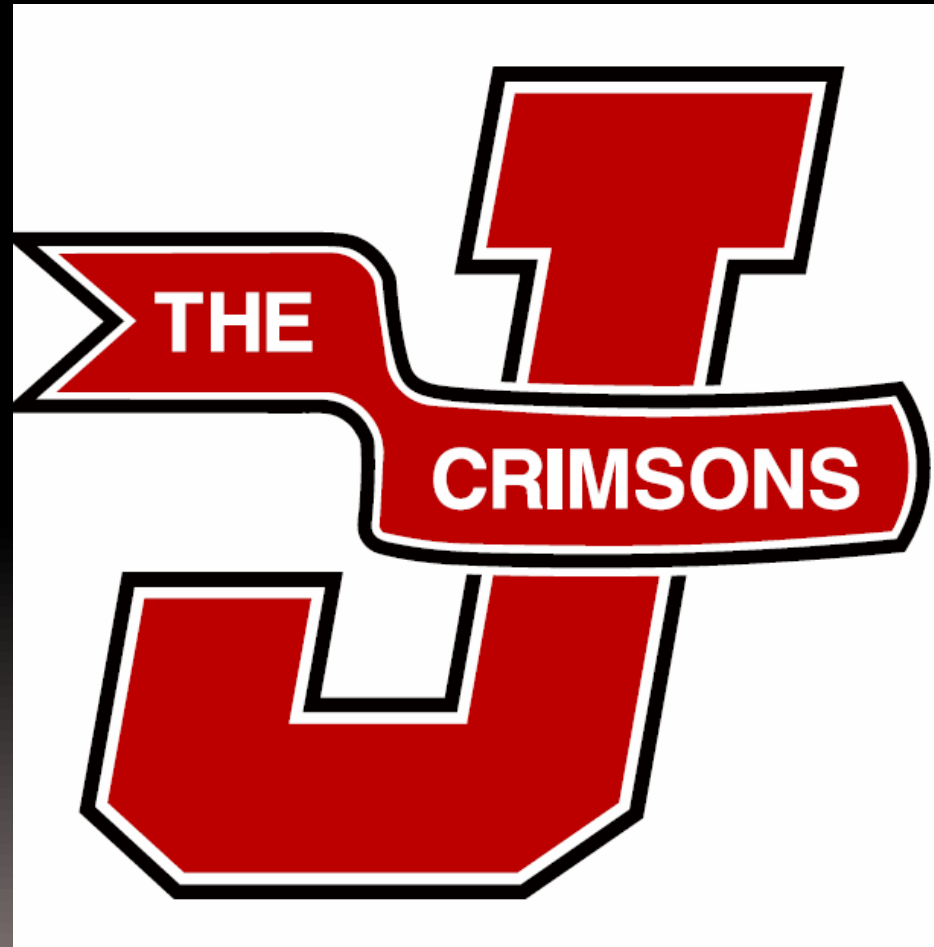

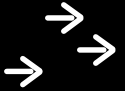

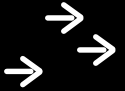

 This program is subject to change as deemed necessary by administration.**

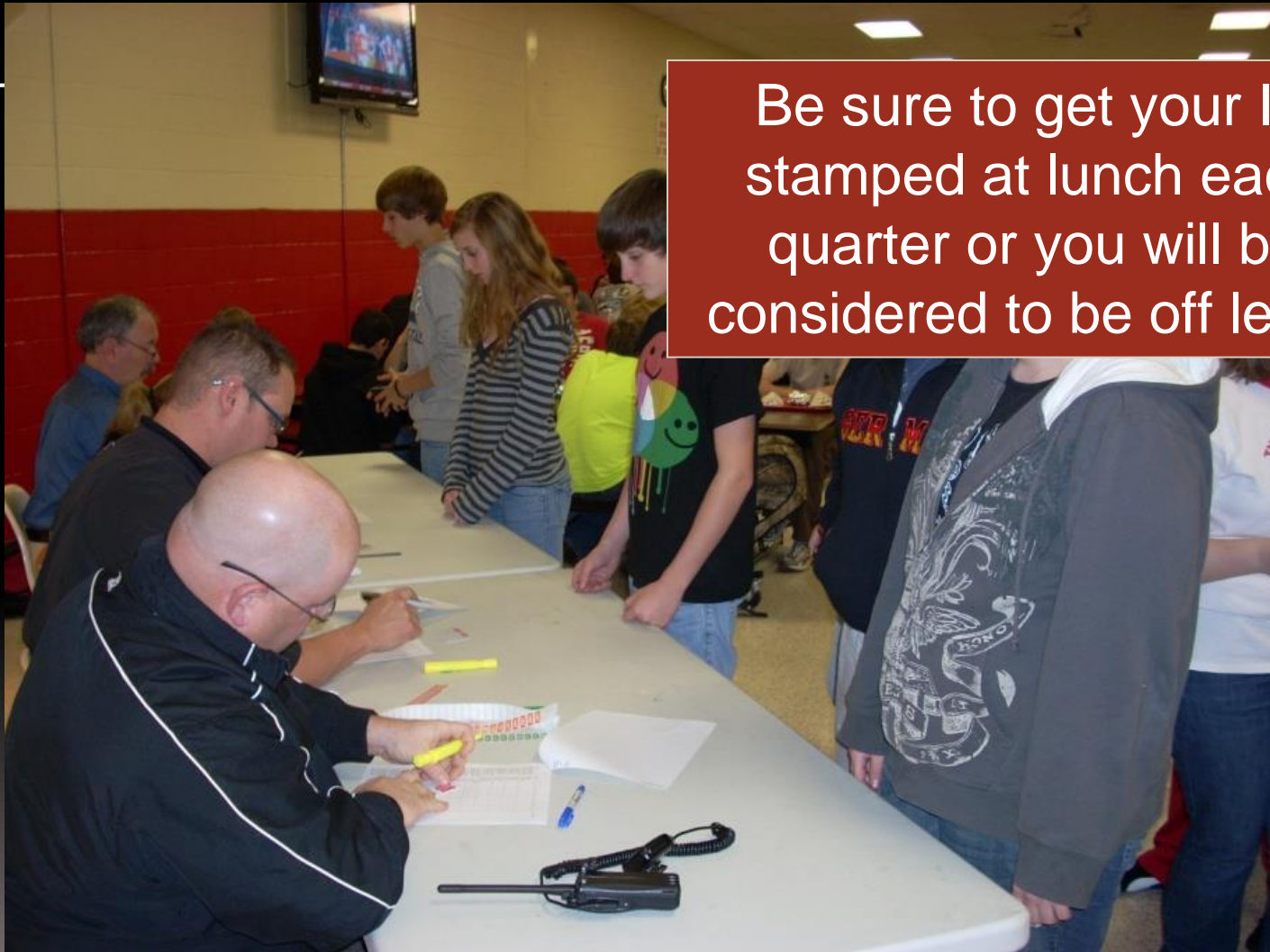
WHAT DO YOU GET IF YOU MEET THE EXPECTATIONS?
