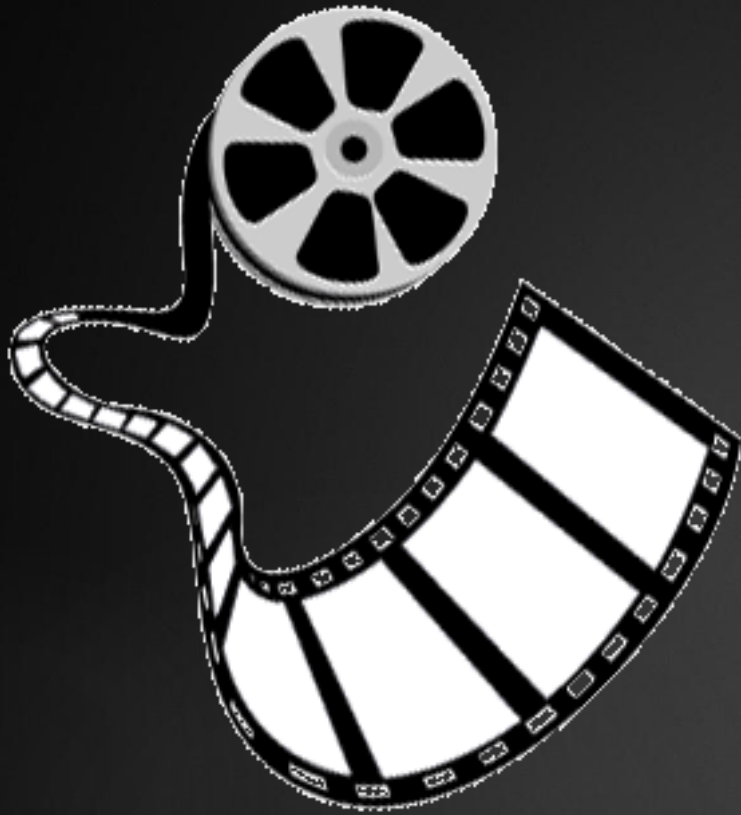


# CRIMSON PRIDE TARDY POLICY

- ▶ 15<sup>th</sup> tardy: Parent Conference and ODR
- ▶ 20<sup>th</sup> tardy: AEP
