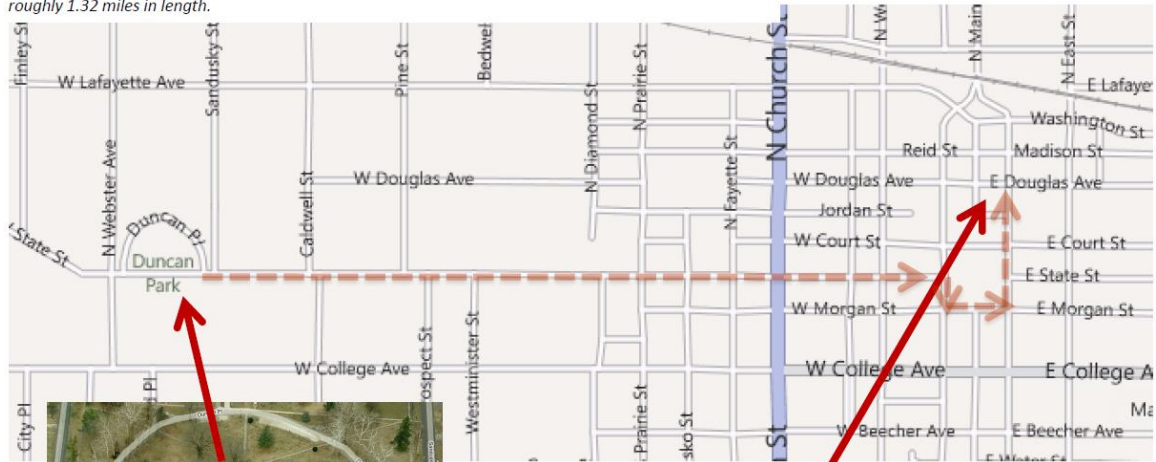

JACKSONVILLE HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE ROUTE, 2018

THEME: HOME SWEET HOMECOMING

Line-Up begins at 3 PM, **Sept. 14.**
The parade officially begins at 4 PM.

The parade route moves east along State Street, continues around the square and ends at Douglas. It is roughly 1.32 miles in length.



The parade route begins at Duncan Park. Floats will line up on the north and south sides of State Street – between Sandusky and Webster. We will also use the north and south side of State Street between Webster and Finley.



The parade route **ends** just beyond the Illinois Theater. Notice the parking lot at the corner of Douglas and Mauvaisterre.

Numbers start near Sandusky and move up towards Webster – along the south side of State. Numbers continue *from roughly 20* again at Sandusky and move up in number towards Webster – and into Duncan Park. We will also use the north and south side of State Street between Webster and Finley.
